In 1996 Commissioners Court established a general obligation commercial paper program secured by ad valorem taxes for the purpose of financing various short-term assets and temporary construction financing for certain long-term fixed assets. The program at this time consists of nine series totaling \$1.65 billion. The Series A-1 (\$100 million), Series B (\$40 million), Series D (\$200 million), Series D-2 (\$200 million), Series D-3 (\$200 million) and Series H (\$250 million) notes are payable from the limited tax. The Series C (\$260 million) notes are payable from an unlimited tax. The Series E-1 (\$200 million) and Series E-2 (\$200 million) notes are payable from revenues
